

# Tanni Grey Thompson

TANNI GREY THOMPSON THE GREAT GOLD MEDALIST WAS BORN ON THE 26 OF JULY 1969 IN CARDIFF. SHE HAD 1 TWO YEAR OLD SISTER CALLED SIAN. TANNI STARTED TO RIDE A WHEELCHAIR AT AGE 7.

These are some of the places she came in some of her wheelchair races. She was a 6 time winner at the London wheelchair marathon and the first woman in the world to break two hours for the marathon.

SHE ALSO WAS THE FIRST PERSON TO BREAK 1 MINUTE FOR THE 400M RACE. 30 WORLD RECORDS BROKEN, 5 GOLD MEDALS, 4 SILVER MEDALS AND 1 BRONZE MEDAL.
