<b>Summary/description: (1hr 40mins)</b>		
<p>Teacher leads discussion on what friendships are and mean. Students are asked for examples from their own lives. (15 mins)</p> <p>Students are shown video clip of Georgian/Russian conflict. Students are given news article. (10 mins)</p> <p>Students are given task sheet Students are given instruction in the crucial skills of writing to persuade. (15mins)</p> <p>Students carry out task – either by piece of writing or by using images and photostory. (40 mins)</p> <p>Peer review and discussion on strengths of work. (20 mins)</p>
